Rules & Regulations

- 1. All persons on the grounds are present with the understanding that SJH Equestrian LLC, Over The Moon Farm, show staff/employees, and show officials are not responsibility for any loss or injury which may occur due to a presence at the show.
- 2. All entry forms must be completed in full with a blank check and proof of negative coggins at the office before a number will be issued.
- 3. SJH Equestrian LLC reserves the right to cancel, vary or combine any classes if the entries dictate a necessity. This will be done in accordance with WNEPHA rules.
- 4. In the event that an entrant withdraws from all classes, or the event that a horse is brought to school only, office fees will be charged.
- 5. All rated classes are run in accordance with the Western New England Professional Horsemen's Association guidelines, as well as those of affiliated organizations when applicable.
- 6. Any questions or disputes shall be referred to the show committee, whose decision is final.
- 7. The listed officials have been invited to officiate. SJH Equestrian LLC reserves the right to vary these names if the situation requires it.
- 8. A \$35 fee will be issued for any checks returned by the bank for lack of funds.
- 9. Protective headgear must be worn at all times while mounted on the show grounds.
- 10. All dogs must be controlled by leash if brought to Over the Moon Farm.
- 11. Schooling will be available from prior to 9:00am in the show ring and will be lowered to 18" prior to the first class, schooling break at each height prior to class as marked on the classlist.

Class Definitions

Equitation Classes

Short Stirrup Equitation – Fences not to exceed 18" in height. Open to riders 12 and under. Simple changes will not be penalized. Riders may not enter any other divisions except those in which the fence height does not exceed 18" and the pleasure division.

Long Stirrup Equitation – Fences not to exceed 18"in height. Open to riders 13 and over who have never competed in any classes where the fence height exceeds 2'. Simple changes will not be penalized. Riders may only enter in classes where the fence height does not exceed 2' and pleasure division.

Pre-Children's/Adult Equitation – Open to any riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'3" in a recognized show. Simple changes will not be penalized, fences not to exceed 2'.

Children's Equitation – Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 2'6". To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'6" with at least one change of direction. No combinations.

Adult Equitation – Open to riders 18 years of age and over. Fences not to exceed 2'9".

Modified Junior Equitation – Open to junior riders who have never competed over fences exceeding 3'. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 2'9" with at least one change of direction. May contain combinations.

Junior Equitation – Open to all junior riders who are not eligible for Pre-Children's or Children's Equitation. To be shown over a course of fences at a height of 3' with at least one change of direction. May contain combinations.

Hunter Classes

BABY GREEN HUNTER DIVISION - Open to any horse in their first or second year of showing over fences who has never shown higher than 2'6" in said 1st or 2nd year. Horses that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at that show in which fence heights exceed 2'6". No oxers. No rider restrictions. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. Trotting in corners will not be penalized. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

LOW HUNTER DIVISION - Open to all horses and ponies and riders with no age limitations. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. Fences not to exceed 2'6". Ramped oxers permitted.

PRE-CHILD-ADULT HUNTER DIVISION - Open to any rider who is eligible for Pre-Child/Adult equitation as of December 1 of the current show year. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. Riders who enter this division at a given show may not enter any other hunter class at that show in which fence height exceeds 2'3"and no equitation/Medal class that exceeds 2'6". The course will not include any combinations or oxers. Fences not to exceed 2'.

NOVICE HUNTER DIVISION - Open to all horses and ponies and junior or amateur riders. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. Riders who enter this division must be novice type riders and at a given show

may not enter any other hunter class at that show in which fence height exceeds 2'3" and no equitation/Medal class that exceeds 2'6". The course will not include any combinations or oxers. Fences not to exceed 2'3".

JUNIOR/AMATEUR HUNTER DIVISION - Open to all except professional riders. No horse restrictions. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. Horse/rider combinations that enter this division at a given show may not enter any other class at the show in which fence height exceeds 2'6". No combinations. Ramped oxers permitted. Fences not to exceed 2'6".

CHILDREN'S HUNTER PONY DIVISION - Open to all ponies ridden by juniors. Small ponies, 12.2 hands and under to jump 2'. Medium ponies, 12.2 but not exceeding 13.2 to jump 2'3". Large ponies, over 13.2 but not to exceed 14.2 to jump 2'6". Judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness.

CHILDREN'S HUNTER HORSE DIVISION - Open to horses to be shown by junior riders. Fences not to exceed 3' for horses. Ramped oxers permitted. Judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness.

OPEN WORKING HUNTER DIVISION - Fences to be 3' Ramped oxers permitted. No restrictions on age or status of rider. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness.

ADULT HUNTER DIVISION - Open to horses ridden by Amateur riders. Fences not to exceed 3'. Ramped oxers permitted. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness.

WNEPHA Medals

All riders must be eligible for the respective equitation division to be eligible for that medal and be a current WNEPHA member prior to the start of the class. All medal classes require 4 entries to run, and judges are encouraged to test the top riders.

WNEPHA Medals

All riders must be eligible for the respective equitation division to be eligible for that medal and be a current WNEPHA member prior to the start of the class. All medal classes require 3 entries to run, and judges are encouraged to test the top riders.

WNEPHA SHORT STIRRUP MEDAL CLASS - Open to junior members of the WNEPHA who are eligible for Short Stirrup Equitation. Riders in this class may compete in any equitation class in which the fence height does not exceed 2'. Rider must be a member before the class begins. A course of at least eight fences not to exceed 18" with at least one change of

direction. No combinations or oxers should be included. Simple changes will not be penalized. A minimum of 3 riders is needed to fill the class.

WNEPHA LONG STIRRUP MEDAL CLASS - Open to junior and amateur members of the WNEPHA who are eligible for Long Stirrup, (13 years of age and over). Riders in this class may compete in any equitation class in which the fence height does not exceed 2'. Rider must be a member before the class begins. A course of at least eight fences not to exceed 18" with at least one change of direction. No combinations or oxers should be included. Simple changes will not be penalized. A minimum of 3 riders is needed to fill the class.

WNEPHA PRE-CHILD/ADULT MEDAL CLASS - Open to junior and amateur members of the WNEPHA who are eligible for Pre-Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. Riders in this class may compete in any equitation class in which the fence height does not exceed 2'6". Rider must be a member before the class begins. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences at a height of 2'. Must include at least one change of direction. No combinations or oxers. Simple changes will not be penalized. A minimum of 3 riders is needed to fill the class.

WNEPHA CHILDREN'S MEDAL CLASS - Open to junior members of the WNEPHA who are eligible for Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. Riders in this class may compete in any equitation class in which the fence height does not exceed 2'9". Rider must be a member before the class begins. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences at a height of 2'6 with at least one change of direction. No combinations. Ramped oxers permitted. A minimum of 3 riders is needed to fill the class.

WNEPHA MODIFIED JUNIOR MEDAL CLASS - Open to junior members of the WNEPHA who are eligible for Modified Junior Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. Riders in this class may compete in any class in which the fence height does not exceed 3' Rider must be a member before the class begins. A course of at least eight fences not to exceed 2'9" with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional. Ramped oxers are allowed. A minimum of 3 riders is needed to fill the class.

WNEPHA JUNIOR MEDAL CLASS - Open to all junior members of the WNEPHA who are not eligible for Pre-Children's, or Children's Equitation. Riders may show horses or ponies. Rider must be a member before the class begins. To be shown over a course of at least 8 fences at a height of 3' with at least one change of direction. Combinations are optional. Ramped oxers are allowed. A minimum of 3 riders is needed to fill the class.

WNEPHA ADULT MEDAL CLASS - Open to Amateur Adult members of the WNEPHA. Riders may show horses or ponies. Rider must be a member before the class begins. A course of at least eight fences not to exceed 2'6" with at least one change of direction must be included. Ramped oxers are allowed. No combinations. A minimum of 3 riders is needed to fill the class.

Miscellaneous

LEADLINE DIVISION - Open to beginner riders age 10 and under who have never shown off the lead line before. Riders may not enter any other division. To be eligible for year-end participation ribbon, riders must compete at two shows during the season. Show secretary must submit proof of participation. Riders need not be a member to be eligible for this award.

WALK TROT DIVISION - Open to riders 12 and under who have never shown at the canter. Riders may not enter any other division. To be eligible for a year-end participation ribbon, riders must accumulate a minimum of 28 points throughout the season. Riders must be members of the WNEPHA. 3 barn rule does apply.

BEGINNER EQUITATION DIVISION - Open to junior and amateur riders beyond the Walk Trot level looking to transition into Short/Long Stirrup Equitation. Canter may be individual or small group, at judge's discretion. One class in division should include a ground pole course, trotting not to be penalized. To be eligible for a year-end participation ribbon, riders must accumulate a minimum of 28 points throughout the season and adhere to the 3 barn rule. Riders must be members of the WNEPHA.

PLEASURE DIVISION - May include Open Pleasure, Road Hack, Bridle Path Hack, Hunter Pleasure. Classes must be open to all horses and ponies and all riders. To be shown on the flat only at a walk, trot, and canter both ways of the ring. Riders may show horses or ponies. To be judged on manners, performance, suitability, and soundness. Martingales not permitted.

Capital District Hunter Jumper Council

BEGINNER WALK-TROT EQUITATION ● Open to Adult Amateur and Junior riders who have never competed in over fences classes. ● Rail classes should include standards next to the rails as jumps have. ● Riders are not eligible to participate in any other classes where riders are required to canter or jump. ● Division to consist of at least two Walk-Trot classes and two Walk-Trot poles classes. ● Classes may be split into two sections at the discretion of the horse show management: Under 13 and 13 & Over. ● Martingales are allowed on the flat. ● A multi-day horse show may run two Beginner Walk-Trot Equitation Divisions, each taking place on a separate day. ● Riders will become ineligible for the Beginner Walk-Trot Division once they have competed in Walk-Trot-Canter classes at three separate horse shows. ● Riders will become ineligible for this division the following competition year once they have competed in over fences class at a horse show. ● Riders cannot receive a year-end High Score Award in both the Beginner Walk-Trot and Beginner Cross Rail Divisions. ● The CDHJC will offer a year-end High Score Award, which may be split into two sections at the discretion of the Board.

BEGINNER CROSSRAIL EQUITATION ● Open to Adult Amateur and Junior riders who have never competed in over fences classes with fence height exceeding 18". ● Fences to be cross rails with proper or no groundline. No combinations. ● Riders are not eligible to participate in any other classes except Pleasure classes and age-appropriate flat classes. ● Division to consist of at least two Walk-Trot-Canter classes, two canter poles classes and two cross rail classes. ●

Classes may be split into two sections at the discretion of the horse show management Under 13 and 13 & Over. • Martingales are allowed on the flat. • A multi-day horse show may run two Beginner Cross Rail Equitation Divisions, each taking place on a separate day. • Riders will become ineligible for the Beginner Cross Rail Division the following competition year once they have competed in classes with fence height at 2' or higher OR one year after earning the End of the Year High Score Award Championship. • Riders are not eligible to receive a year end High Score Award in both the Beginner Walk-Trot and Beginner Cross Rails Divisions. • The CDHJC will offer a year-end High Score Award, which may be split into two sections at the discretion of the Board.

SHORT/LONG STIRRUP EQUITATION ● Open to Adult Amateur and Junior riders who have never competed in over fences classes with fence height exceeding 2′. ● Fences height to be 18″ verticals with appropriate groundlines or flowerboxes. No combinations. ● Riders are not eligible to participate in any other classes except Pleasure classes, age-appropriate equitation flat classes and those classes where fence height does not exceed 18″ at the same horse show. 13 ● Classes may be split into two sections at the discretion of the horse show management Under 13 and 13 & Over. ● Martingales are allowed on the flat. ● A multi-day horse show may run two Short/Long Stirrup Equitation Divisions, each taking place on a separate day. ● Riders will become ineligible for this division the following year once they have competed in classes with fence height at 2′3″ or higher OR one year after earning the End of the Year High Score Award Championship. ● The CDHJC will offer a year-end High Score Award, which may be split into two sections at the discretion of the Board.

2' CHILD/ADULT EQUITATION • Open to Adult Amateur and Junior riders who, as of December 1st of the current show year, have not won six (6) blue ribbons at a horse show at 2'6" or higher. • Riders who have won six (6) blue ribbons are eligible for this division if, as of December 1st of the current show year, they have not shown in classes with fences 2'6" or higher at more than three (3) horse shows within the past year. • Riders may show horses or ponies. • To be shown over a course of fences at 2'. No combinations. • At the same show, the same horse/rider or pony/rider combination may not cross enter into any class that exceeds 2'3". • Classes may be split into two sections, Child and Adult, at the discretion of the horse show management. • The CDHJC will offer a year-end High Score Award, which may be split into two sections at the discretion of the Board.

OPEN PLEASURE HORSE/PONY ● No championship points will be counted unless those classes which determine the championship are open to all horses and ponies with no restrictions as to age or qualifications of rider.

OPEN 2' HUNTER ● Open to all horses and ponies. ● To be shown over a course of at least eight (8) fences at 2'. Combinations are not permitted. ● USHJA Open 2' and 2' Schooling Classes will count for points. ● Classes may be split into two sections, Professional and Non-Pro, at the discretion of the horse show management. ● CDHJC will offer an End of Year High Score Award, which may be split into two divisions at the discretion of the Board.

OPEN 2'3" HUNTER ● Open to all horses and ponies. ● To be shown over a course of at least eight (8) fences at 2'3". Combinations are not permitted. ● USHJA Open 2'3" and 2'3" Schooling Classes will count for points. ● Classes may be split into two sections, Professional and Non-Pro, at the discretion of the horse show management. ● CDHJC will offer an End of Year High Score Award, which may be split into two divisions at the discretion of the Board.

RALPH P. SYMMES CLASS ● Open to Junior Members of the CDHJC. ● Fences will be set at 3′0″. ● In addition to the High Score Awards pointed classes, all member shows will be required to offer the Ralph P. Symmes Medal Class. ● A show may elect to use a flat phase in addition to the fence class, but only on a 50/50 basis. ● The entry fee for this class will be the same as that for a regular open equitation class. ● A minimum of six (6) ribbons must be awarded. ● A minimum of three (3) riders must complete the course in order for the class to be valid. ● One (1) win or a total of five (5) points qualifies a rider for the Finals. Points are as follows: 1st-5pts, 2nd - 3 pts, 3rd - 2 pts, 4th - 1 pt. ● The Annual CDHJC Show may choose to offer multiple Symmes classes. ● Riders may continue to ride in the Symmes Class after qualifying for the finals. ● The Symmes Finals Medal Class may be won by an individual only once. ● A final class will be held at a designated show for those riders who qualify. The finals will consist of a jumping phase followed by a flat phase for the riders selected at the discretion of the judge. Each phase will count 50%. ● Qualified riders will be sent an invitation to ride in this class and only those riders so invited will be eligible to ride. ● There will be an End of Year Year-End High Score Award given to the rider with the most points.

Miscellaneous

Leadline – Open to beginner riders age 10 and under who have never shown off the lead line before. Riders may not enter any other division.

Walk/Trot – Open to riders 12 and under who have never shown at the canter. Riders may not enter any other division.

Beginner Equitation – Open to riders of any age beyond the Walk Trot level not showing in Short/Long Stirrup Equitation. Canter may be individual or small group. One class in division should include a ground pole course, trotting not to be penalized. Riders must be members of the WNEPHA.

Pleasure – May include Open Pleasure, Road Hack, Bridle Path Hack, Hunter Pleasure. Open to all horses and ponies. To be shown on the flat only at a walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring. Judged on manners performance, suitability and soundness. Martingales not permitted. May include backing, loose rein, hand gallop, extension and collection.
